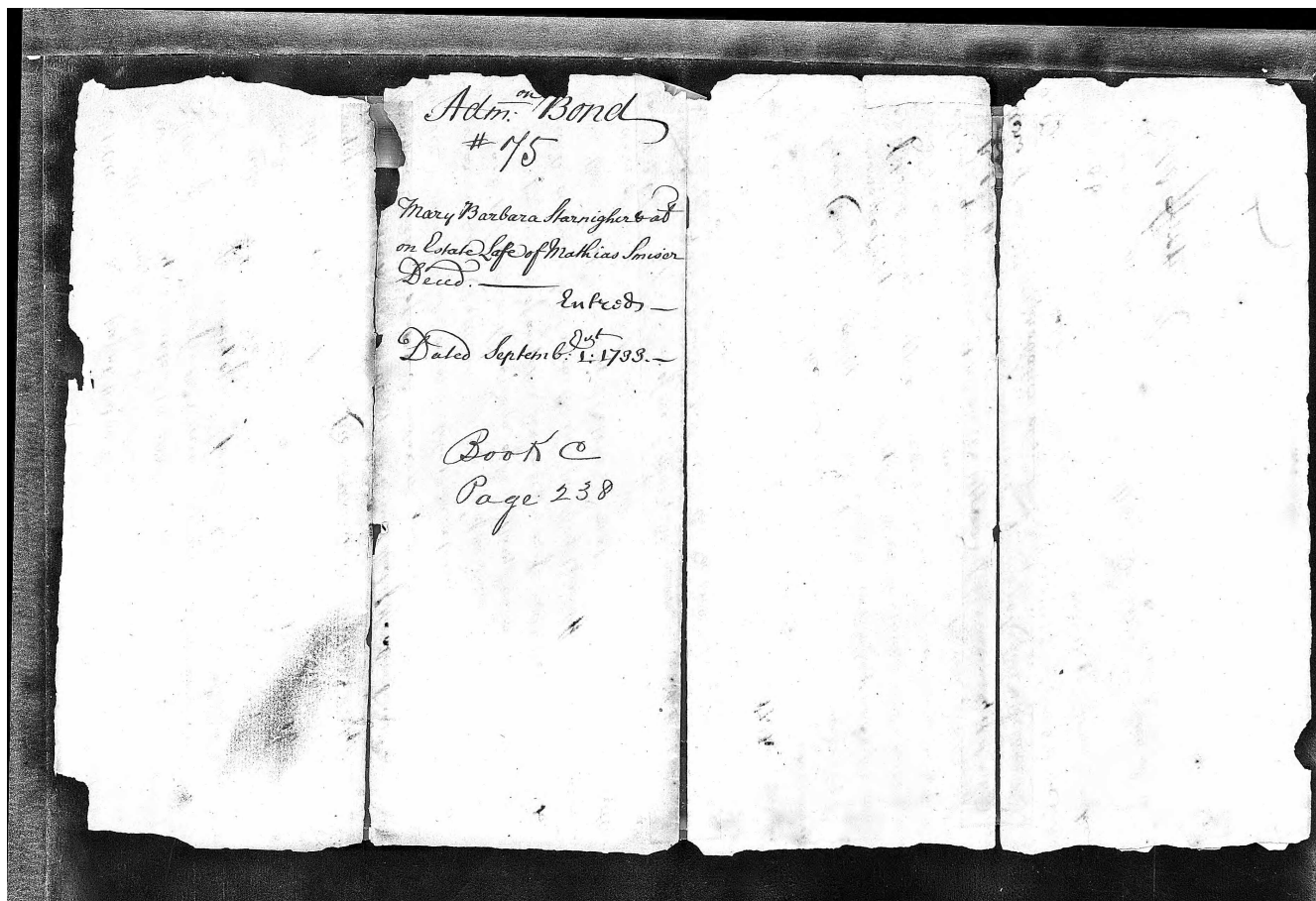

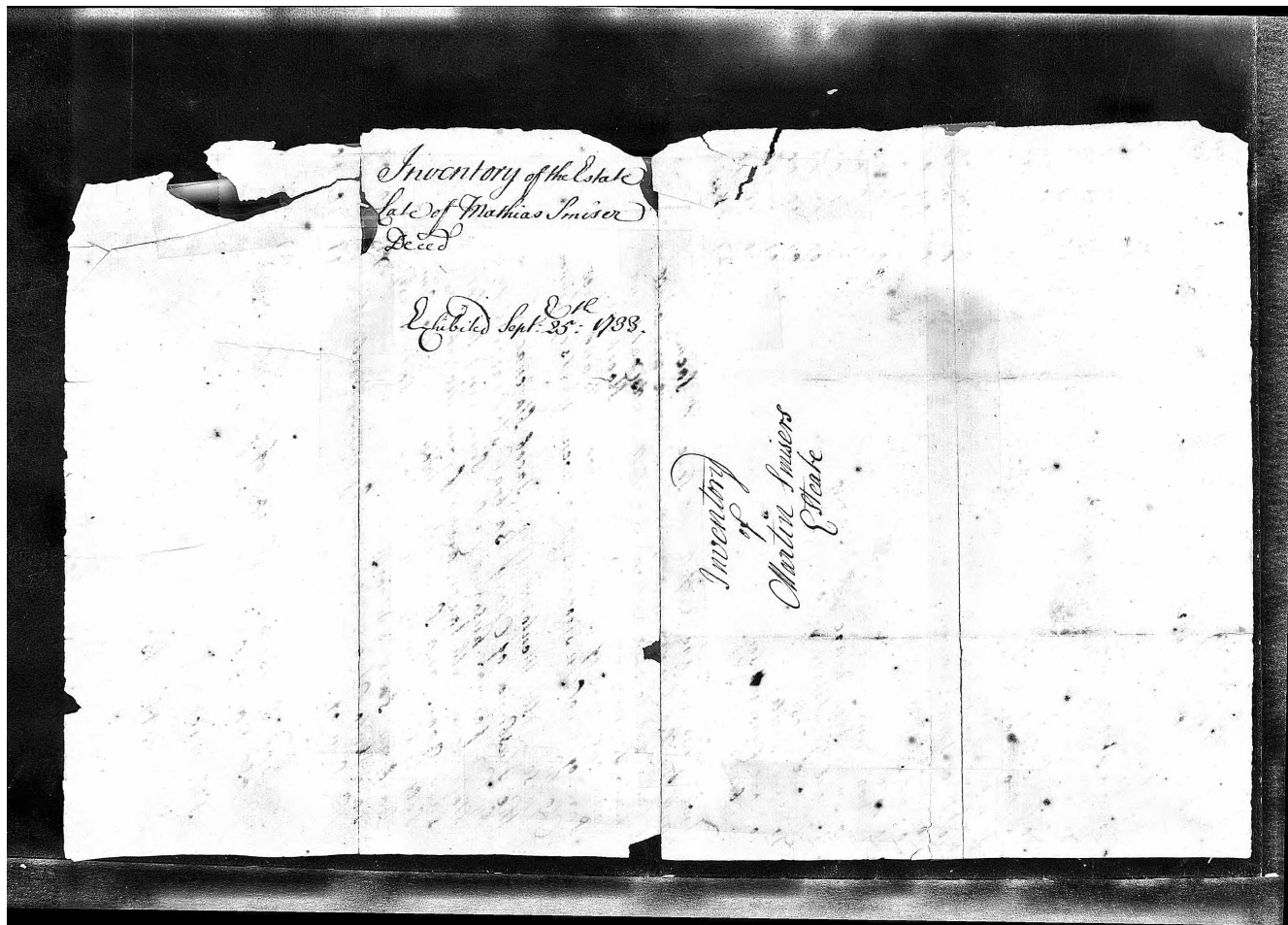

County & Christian Oyster of the same County Yeom. are held & firmly bound unto Peter Evans Reg. Gen. for the probate of Wills & granting Letters of Admin. in & for the Province of Pennsylvania in the sum of Two hundred & fiftie lawfull money of the P. province to be paid to the P. Reg. Gen. his certain he certain <sup>by</sup> Exec. Adm. or assigns to the <sup>due</sup> paymt. well & truly to be made & done We do bind our selves our heirs Exec. & Adm. jointly & severally for in the whole firmly by these presents sealed with our Seals dated the first day of September In the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & thirty three.

The condition of this obligation is such, that if the above bound Mary Barbara Starnigher Adm. of all & singular the Goods Rights & Credits of Mathias Smiser Deceased do make or cause to be made a true & perfect Inventory of all & singular the Goods Chattles Rights & Credits of the P. Deceased. w. have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the P. Mary Barbara or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her & the same do make or exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Reg. Gen. office at Philad. at or before the first day of October next, and the same Goods & Chattles w. were of the P. Deceased. at the time of his death or at any time after shall come to the hands or possession of the P. Mary Barbara or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her do well & truly Administer according to law, and further do make or cause to be made a true & just Accot. of the P. Adm. at or before the second day of September Anno Dom. 1734. and all the rest & residue of the P. Goods Chattles Rights & Credits w. shall be found remaining upon the P. Adm. Accot. the same being first examined & allowed of by the Orphans Court of the County of Philad. shall deliver & pay to such person or persons respectively as the P. Court by its Decree or Sentence shall limit & appoint And if it shall hereafter appear that any last Will or Testam. was made by the P. Deceased. & the Exec. or Exec. therein named do prohibit the same into the P. office making request to have it allowed & approved of accordingly if the said Mary Barbara Starnigher being thereunto requested do Render & deliver the said

Wills of Admin. Approbation of such Testam. being first had & made in the P. Office Then this obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force & virtue.
